Firewood Supply

- Seasoned firewood is in short supply
- Limited Information
- Description of firewood market
- Assumed Causes



Limited Information

- Firewood markets are not closely tracked Most firewood is self-supplied
 State conducts a household survey every five years
- Anecdotal information
 Wood is available, but the price is "high"
 Seasoned wood may not always be available
 Forestry firewood permits do not seem to be spiking

Firewood Market

- Three main uses:
 - Primary heating,
 Supplemental heating
 Recreational/Camping
- Dominated by "cordwood"
- About 60% of firewood is self-supplied
- More kiln operators now (4)



Firewood Market

■ Total use:


MPCA – 1.2 million cords for heating US EIA – 600,000 cords

Households:

MPCA – 130,000 primary / 130,000 secondary Census – 50,000 primary




Households Heating With Wood

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Assumed Causes

- 2013-14 Saw draw down of firewood stockpiles.
 - Cold winter = heating demand
 - High propane prices = more supplemental heating
- Air drying fire wood requires long lead times
- Weather may have slowed fire wood production
