Minnesota energy policy background

LEC staff is preparing background on energy and energy policy in Minnesota. Beginning with short answers to questions posed by legislators in 2015, staff is now compiling a single document that is intended to serve as an introduction to and overview of the topic. The document will be shared with LEC members and available publicly on the commission's website.
